- Late registration as spaces allow.
- Coaches want to send in a list and have those kids put on their rosters. Many parents registering have the idea that the teams are formed by the coaches. For rec soccer the registrar forms the teams. The players can request a team or coach or friend. The registrars will do their best to group kids by their requests. Coaches should not promise spots to families. We have had a few situations this year where a spot was promised but we have not been able to accommodate the player on that team - makes for a difficult situation all around. Coaches should encourage kids to sign up.
- Kids have to sign up for their correct age group and request to play up. Rosters should be mostly done by late June. Use your team page to view your roster. Easy to set up.
- We have activated Coach Tools for coaches U9 and up so they could see who has and has not registered – to be clear rosters are not finalized and things may change. We have not activated coach tools for U6, U7, and U8 yet - too much to be done and too much uncertainty to release the rosters at this time but I am working on them.
- Your roster will not be finalized until August so don't tell kids they are on your team until you hear from us that your roster has been finalized.
- Need to combine teams at U11, U12 - have a tentative plan - keeping an eye on the numbers and still need a few coaches.
- Still need coaches in general - maybe people have not registered for this year?

- Academy Training program for training this year will be mandatory for U8-14. Program focused on developing players skills and coaches coaching skills. Objective is to provide a substantially better training program to the club that will enhance the overall experience of players and coaches.
